Our first stop is Panama City, where we stay at the historic Hotel Central, the very first hotel in Panama, located in the charming Casco Viejo, in the "old" capital of Panama. We will cruise along the Panama Canal on our private chartered boat to see the ships transiting the canal and then we are off on a jungle trek. Later, we will tour the Miraflores lock and see the ships being raised and lowered from the Pacific Ocean to the level of the canal.

Next, we're off to La Antigua, Guatemala, founded almost 500 years ago and known for its stunning architecture and rich culture. At one time the capital of Guatemala, the city is nestled in the lush mountains.

Finally, we'll visit Puebla, Mexico, home to CST Flight Services. Puebla is known for its colonial architecture, plethora of beautiful churches, museums, and archaeological sites. Sample Puebla's iconic cuisine and visit the Talavera factories where the beautiful pottery is made by hand. See where the battle of "5 de mayo" was fought.



TAPACHULA, MEXICO DAY 1: SATURDAY

We will depart from Brownsville, TX (KBRO) and fly south to Veracruz, Mexico (MMVR) for our entry into Mexico and a fuel stop. Once we have completed the formalities in Veracruz, our next destination will be Tapachula, Mexico (MMTP), where we will be staying overnight.

PANAMA CITY, PANAMA DAY 2: SUNDAY

Our journey continues as we depart Tapachula and proceed to Liberia, Costa Rica (MRLB), to refuel and pick up boxed lunches. Once completed, we will proceed to our destination, Marcos A. Gelabert Airport (MPMG) in Panama City. After completing the arrival procedures and securing the aircraft, we will transfer to the Central Hotel, the first hotel of Panama in the heart of Panama City's historic Casco Viejo. After checking in, we will gather for a delightful dinner at the hotel.

DAY 3: MONDAY

Our guided tour will start after breakfast where we proceed by private bus to the Panama Canal and the nearby jungle. Our private, chartered boat will take us across Gatun Lake in the Panama Canal, to watch the monumental cargo ships passing by. We will continue our boat cruise around rainforest-covered islands, where we can observe the local wildlife. We'll also visit attractions like the Commission Building, Goethals monument, Albrook US Air Force Station, and Fort Clayton former US army base at the Panama Canal. We'll wrap up the tour with a visit to the Miraflores Locks and Exhibition Center to watch the ships being raised and lowered from the canal to sea level. After lunch, we'll head back to Casco Viejo.

DAY 4: TUESDAY

Day at leisure! During this day, you will have the opportunity to explore Panama at your own pace. Wander through the charming streets of Casco Viejo and visit its monuments, museums, and shops. If you're interested, additional tours can be organized upon request.

Consider taking a day trip to El Valle de Anton, a lovely town set within a dormant volcanic crater. You can also visit the fascinating Biodiversity Museum designed by Frank Gehry. Discover the delicious local cuisine and delve deeper into the city's culture.

Alternatively, you can explore Portobelo, an ancient Spanish fortress and Caribbean port, or learn about the traditions of the indigenous Embera village. In the evening, we'll gather for a pre-flight briefing and enjoy a lovely dinner together.

DAY 5: WEDNESDAY

Once we finish breakfast, we will leave Panama and fly to Liberia, Costa Rica (MRLB) to refuel and pick up another boxed lunch before continuing our journey to Guatemala City's La Aurora International Airport (MGGT). After completing the arrival formalities, we will begin our journey up the mountains to the Hotel Camino Real in the charming city of La Antigua. This city was declared a World Heritage Site in 1979 by UNESCO due to its stunning colonial architecture and strong Mayan influence. After checking in at the hotel, we will gather for dinner at the hotel restaurant.

Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner




DAY 6: THURSDAY

The group walking tour for today will start right after breakfast from the hotel lobby. We'll have a guided walking tour of La Antigua, where we'll learn about its history and explore the fascinating attractions that make this place one of a kind. You'll have free time in the afternoon to relax or further explore the city at your own leisure. Lunch and dinner will be on your own.

DAY 7: FRIDAY

You have the day at leisure! Explore La Antigua and it's beautiful surroundings at your own pace. For those inclined, there are optional tours available to visit nearby attractions such as volcanoes, lakes, and Mayan archeological sites. Alternatively, you may choose to visit local museums, the market, historic landmarks in La Antigua, or the Chocolate Museum!. Another option is to relax and rejuvenate at the hotel Spa, gardens, or pool. We will gather at the hotel later for a preflight briefing and dinner.

We will have an early start to transfer to La Aurora International Airport for international departure procedures. We will make the short flight to make our mandatory entry into Mexico at the Tapachula Intl. Airport (MMTP) to complete the arrival formalities and to pick up our boxed lunches. Once we are done, we will continue our journey to Puebla (MMPB) and transfer by private van to the Hotel Quinta Real, located in the Historic Center of the City. Finally, we will gather for a pleasant dinner at the hotel.

DAY 9: SUNDAY

The City of Puebla in Mexico is a truly remarkable place, surrounded by stunning mountains and volcanoes. To explore its rich history and culture, we'll start the day with a touristic trolley car ride through the Historic Center, visiting all the amazing landmarks.

After lunch, you can discover the city at your own pace. Museums offer insights into both pre-Hispanic heritage and contemporary art, while street markets showcase beautiful artisanal products created by talented artists. Visit the Capilla del Rosario, considered one of the greatest artistic-religious achievements in Mexico or any one of the other amazing attractions. Enjoy the local atmosphere!

DAY 10: MONDAY

Day at leisure! Spend the day exploring Cholula, a captivating "Magic Town" that is home to the world's largest pyramid in terms of volume.

Alternatively, wander through the streets of the Historic Center and marvel at the well-preserved colonial architecture, both civil and religious. Don't miss the chance to visit the beautiful churches adorned with baroque art. Later, we'll gather for dinner and a pre-flight briefing.

BROWNSVILLE, TEXAS DAY 11. TUESDAY

After breakfast, we will head to the Puebla airport to begin our return to the US. From there, we will fly to Tampico (MMTM) to go through customs and immigration formalities to leave Mexico. Finally, we will fly back to Brownsville South Padre Island International Airport (KBRO).





THIS AGREEMENT (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement") is made on the below-stated date, by and between Mako Leasing Company I, LLC, d/b/a CST Flight Services, and including all of its subsidiaries, members, directors, officers, employees, agents, independent contractors, heirs, representatives, successors and assigns (herein referred to as "CST,") and the undersigned user or prospective user (jointly and severally referred to as the "User" or "I" or "me" or "my,") of some or all of the information and/or services provided by and/or arranged and/or suggested by CST, which information and services include, but are not limited to, its Ground Handling Service, International Permits Service, Airspace Fees Payment Service, APIS submission, Border Overflight Exemption Processing, Online Member Services, and its Fully Escorted Guided Expeditions (hereinafter individually and collectively referred to as the "Services").

WHEREAS, I intend to utilize the Services of CST and to participate as a pilot, passenger or other participant in certain travel to Mexico, Central America, South America, The Bahamas and the Caribbean, arranged by and/or suggested to me, the User, by CST (hereinafter referred toas the "Travel"); and

WHEREAS, I understand that in participating in the Travel, I may be exposed to certain risks, including the risks of injury or death to the me and/or others, and/or damage or destruction of the my property and/or the property of others;

In consideration of the CST's providing me with the Services, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, I agree that:

1. I understand and agree that travel to, from and within Mexico, Central America, South America, The Bahamas and the Caribbean and/or acting as a pilot, or being a passenger, in general aviation aircraft, will expose me to risks, both foreseen and unforeseen, which include the risks of injury or death to me and/or others, and/or damage or destruction to my property and/or the property of others. These risks include but are not limited to the risks of aircraft accidents, incidents and crashes, aircraft malfunctions, drowning, exposure, deep vein thrombosis, disease, parasites, molds, heatstroke, dehydration, insect bites, snake bites, stings, toxic plants and plants which cause allergic reactions, HIV/AIDS infection, dengue fever, malaria, cholera, typhoid fever, paratyphoid fever, polio, hepatitis, food poisoning, and other diseases and risks known or unknown.



- 2. I also understand that medical care and/or emergency response may be of a lower quality than that expected in the United States of America, or that even if the medical care and/or emergency response is of a similar quality, it may be difficult or impossible to receive medical care and/or emergency response in time for it to be effective to prevent my death, the death of
- others, my injury or the injury to others, the extent of my injury or the injury to others, or the damage of my property or the property of others.
- 3. With full knowledge and understanding of the foregoing, and with full understanding of the potential dangers and possible consequences of my use of the Services and the Travel, I hereby, of my own free will and without inducements, promises or statements, other than those contained in this Agreement, EXPRESSLY ASSUME ALL RISKS OF ANY NATURE WHAT-SOEVER FOR ANY DEATH, INJURY OR OTHER DAMAGES to myself, my property, and the person and the property of others, which may arise out of my involvement in the Travel, I KNOW AND FULLY APPRECIATE THAT RELIANCE ON AND/OR USE OF THE SERVICES AND THE TRAVEL EXPOSE ME TO THE RISK OF PERSONAL INJURY AND EVEN DEATH. I FULLY APPRECIATE THE DANGERS AND VOLUNTARILY, EXPRESSLY, ASSUME THESE RISKS.
- 4. For the valuable consideration stated in this Agreement, I do, for myself and for my heirs, representatives, assigns, successors, and administrators, HEREBY EXPRESSLY RELEASE AN WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS for negligence, gross negligence, and for any other cause of action whatsoever, which I may presently or hereafter have, against CST.
- 5. I agree never to institute any suit or action at law or otherwise against CST, or assist in the prsecution of any claim for damages or any cause of action which I may have by reason of injury to my person or any property, or my death, or injury, death or property damage of others, arising from my use or reliance on the Services. I further expressly agree that I will never raise any claim against CST for product liability, failure to warn, negligence, breach of warranty, breach of contract, or strict liability, regardless of whether my claims for damages or injuries are alleged to result from the fault or negligence of CST. I further agree that my heirs, executors, administrators, personal representatives and/or anyone else claiming on my behalf, shall not institute any suit or action at law or otherwise against any of the Released Parties, nor shall they initiate or assist in the prosecution of any claim for damages or cause of action which I, my heirs, executors, personal representatives, and/or anyone else claiming on my behalf may have by reason of injury to my person or any property, or my death, arising from my use or

- 6 .I hereby agree to defend, indemnify, save and hold harmless CST from any and all losses claims, actions or proceedings of every kind and character whatsoever, including but not limited to claims for compensation, consequential, punitive, and other damages, attorneys' fees and third parties, which may arise directly or indirectly as a result of my utilization of the Services and/or the Travel, whether resulting from the negligence, gross negligence, and/or fault, either active or passive, of CST, or from my own negligence, gross negligence and/or fault, either active or passive.
- 7. I certify that considering my lifestyle, the hazardous nature of general aviation, flying an aircraft to, from and within Mexico, Central and South America, The Bahamas and the Caribbean and the Travel in which I am about to engage, and the manner in which I am supporting my dependents, if any, I have made adequate provisions for my spouse, if any, my heirs, if any and all other persons dependent upon me so that in the event of my death or injury they will suffer no financial loss for which I have not made adequate provisions.
- 8. I understand and agree that this Agreement is a legally binding contract. I have executed this

Release of Liability and Waiver of my own free will. I further agree that should any court determine that any clause or provision of this contract is illegal or otherwise unenforceable, such determination shall not affect the validity and enforceability of the remaining provisions hereof, all of which shall remain in full force and effect.

9. I understand and agree that this Agreement applies to all phases of my involvement in the use of the Services and my participation in the Travel, and I agree that THIS DOCUMENT SHALL

BE BROADLY CONSTRUED IN FAVOR OF CST AND AGAINST ME and that any and all ambiguities shall be resolved in favor of any and all of CST.



- 10. I hereby agree and acknowledge that all of the terms and conditions of this Agreement and Waiver shall continue in full force and effect now and in the future at all times during which I utilize the Services or participate in the Travel and shall be binding upon my heirs, executors, administrators, personal representatives and/or anyone else claiming on my behalf.
- 11. The procedural and substantive law of the State of Florida shall apply to any and all issues involving the construction, interpretation and validity of this Agreement, and Florida procedural
- and substantive law shall govern any dispute between the parties hereto arising from the activities covered by this Agreement. Any and all provisions of this Agreement to the contrary notwithstanding, if suit is brought against CST," I hereby explicitly waive my right to a jury trial and agree that the state courts of Miami-Dade County, Florida shall be the sole venue for any suitor action arising from the activities covered by this Agreement.
- 12. This Agreement contains the entire agreement of the parties hereto with respect to the subject matter herein addressed, and all prior understandings and agreements, whether written or oral, between the parties hereto relating to the subject matter of this Agreement are merged in this Agreement or superseded hereby; provided further, however, that if I have executed, or in the future execute any other agreement or agreements containing provisions relating to the Travel, I agree that the agreement which provides the most protection from liability and/or suit to CST shall be deemed to be controlling. This Agreement shall not be amended, modified, or altered without the express, written, consent of all the parties hereto.
